In our ongoing efforts to improve service to our members, we have implemented a "Job Line" system. We will no longer be calling our members asking if they are interested in positions that are available. You are now asked to call the toll free "Job Line" to hear the positions available.

1. The "Job Line" numbers as listed above are toll free and shall be used to bid on a posted job only. We will not return messages or record lay-off dates that are left on this toll free number.
2. By 4:30 pm each day, any positions that are available will be posted on the Job Line. We will check the messages left on the Job Line at 9:00am daily.
3. If you are interested in applying for any position within your classification, leave your name, Union ID#, telephone number, along with the position your are interested in because at times there may be more than one position posted. Only those who apply before 9:00 am on the following day are eligible for Dispatch.
4. When multiple people apply for the same position, we will select the person, in their turn, from the Out of Work List (OWL). You must be on the OWL and must have all required updated certificates. Also your union dues must be paid up to and including the current month.
5. If you are selected for the position, you will receive a call before the end of the day. If you don't receive a call it means the position was filled, and you will remain on the OWL and retain your position.
6. Please continue to call the union hall when you are laid off at (709) 364-5430 or (709) 364-5410. You will be placed back on the OWL the day you contact the union office.
7. We reserve the right to amend and improve this service as it proceeds, if and when any issues arise.
