Brothers and Sisters,

I'd like to inform you of current and future work opportunities, and the hiring of new business representatives/organizers.

In terms of current work, both the Moncton and Fredericton commercial areas are booming, and we are having a hard time filling job orders because there is so much work. Please get in touch with your business representatives if you live in those areas and are looking for work, or if you

are willing to relocate to those areas for commercial work. Please also try to convince any carpenters you know to join our Union.

The industrial world has picked up tremendously since the Winter. The Irving Oil Refinery currently has hundreds of scaffolders there and they are seeking more in the next month. The amount of work at the Refinery for the upcoming shutdown will be beyond the amount of scaffolders we have in the province, to the point that we will likely have to get scaffolders from other Atlantic provinces to fulfill the scaffolding demand of the Fall shutdown.

We have just hired Ben Cornford as the new ISM/Fredericton organizer. I am hopeful that with adding this position we will gain market share in Fredericton and the ISM industry resulting in more employment for New Brunswick drywallers.
