PEI Major Projects Inventory

- Heatherdale Dining Hall (Arsenault Bros/ Aluma)
- Montague Town Hall (WMM)
- UPEI Residence (Arsenault Bros)
- Mark Arendz Ski Resort (Fitz & Snow)
- Sleepy Hollow Jail (Fitz & Snow)
- Morrell Foot Bridge (Dunbar Construction)
- Province House (PCL/RJW/ Heritage Grade)
- Five Year Transportation Capital Plan -Valued at 228 million- will begin in 2021, ends in 2026.
- Green Infrastructure Stream -Valued at 228 million-began in 2019, ends in 2028. Projects will be focused on three areas, greenhouse gas mitigation, (smart grids, renewables, energy efficiency, and transportation.) resistance and disaster mitigation projects, (dikes and wetlands) and environmental quality projects (water and wastewater). The largest projects funded to date are the Summerside Solar and Storage Integration Project.
- Education Capital Spending- valued at 166 million- will begin in 2021, ends in 2026. New schools and renovations is 113 million, as well as new buses, 31.5 million, and classroom technology 18.4 million. Larger projects include a new high school in Stratford, 42 million, a new elementary school in Sherwood, 25 million, and a major renovation of Evangeline, 17 million, and are listed separately.
