As a reminder, Section 31(D) of the Constitution outlines eligibility to run for office:

1. a member must have been (12) twelve months in good standing immediately prior to nomination and be a member of the UBC for two years immediately prior to nomination,
2. the member cannot be receiving a UBCJA pension,
3. the member must be present at the time of nominations unless in the anteroom on authorized business, out on official business, or prevented by accident, sickness, or other substantial reason accepted by the Council from being present,

4. the member must be working/depending on the trade for a livelihood or employed by the union as a full-time officer or representative,
  5. the member must not be a life member; and
  6. the member must not be a contracting member.

Section 31(A) of the Constitution states that a member cannot run for more than one position on the Executive during the same election. Therefore, a member can only be nominated for one of the four (4) vacant Executive positions.

In order to nominate a member for the Local 1009 Executive or to vote in a potential election, you must be in good standing at the time of your nomination and/or election.
